**\*\*\*PLEASE NOTE\*\*\***

1. All players will receive t-shirts with matching socks as their uniform. Shorts are not provided.
2. Players need to be at practices and games. Players may not be guaranteed 50% playing time if they miss practices, games, or are late to a game. Exceptions may be granted for illness, injury, and disciplinary reasons.
3. U8 Players and up should arrive 15 minutes prior to the game for equipment check by the referees. Shin guards are required to play/practice. Shoes cannot have a toe cleat.

**RYSC Code of Conduct**

The RYSC Code of Conduct is part of our By-Laws/Policies and Procedures and must be followed by everyone on the soccer fields. Everyone will act in accord with this code. The league officials will and should expect that everyone follow this code. Anyone not following these rules is subject to disciplinary actions by the Disciplinary Board, not limited to expulsion from club activities.

1. Make soccer participation for your child and others a positive experience.
2. Remember that a child is easily affected by outside influences.
3. Be kind to your child's coach and to the officials. Be kind to the opposing teams parents and their coaches.
4. Applaud good plays by your team AND by members of the opposing team.
5. Parents should be cheerleaders. Allow the coach to coach, the referee to officiate, and most of all allow your child to play the game.
6. Between the exuberance of the winner and the disappointment of the loser, we have the referee. All of them follow the same creed to watch every movement of every player, and to call the game to the best of their ability. **DO NOT** openly question their judgment, and never their honesty. They are a symbol of fair play, integrity and sportsmanship.
7. Accept the results of each game, and encourage your child to: Be gracious in victory, and turn defeat to victory by working towards improvement. Set a good example of sportsmanship for the children.
8. **ABUSIVE OR PROFANE LANGUAGE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED ON THE SOCCER GROUNDS OR TOWARD ANY PERSON IN ATTENDANCE.**

**\*\*We are using a new system, which requires the child's birth certificate. A birth certificate must be on file for child to participate. If one is not, the child's form will be held, till one is made available.**

**\*\*When your child pays/plays in the fall, this includes the spring season as well. Your child will have the same team/coach/shirt in the spring that they have in the fall.**
